COMPOSITION GUIDELINES FOR POSTING ON THE ALCM WEB SITE

ALCM will post the unpublished musical compositions of its members to provide congregations with free, downloadable materials for worship. All pieces submitted will be reviewed on the basis of appropriateness and notational clarity. Members accessing the resources are the final arbiters of the quality of the materials. In order for a piece to be considered for posting, please email to alcm.ofc@comcast.net:

1. a PDF file of the composition with the appropriate copyright notice (see below) on the bottom of the first page; and
2. a TIF file for any assembly/congregation part.

All texts must be in the public domain or permission must be secured from the author. Scriptural and liturgical settings, original hymns, and organ and other instrumental works are welcomed. Special consideration will be given to unison, two-part, and SAB liturgical responses and anthems that will serve small church choirs and children's choirs well.
